



32nd Annual Meeting of the Bioelectromagnetics Society First Call for Abstracts

The Bioelectromagnetics Society (BEMS) will hold its **32nd Annual Meeting** at the Seoul KyoYuk MunHwa HoeKwan Hotel in Seoul, South Korea on **June 14-18, 2010** (for site contact info see below).

Dariusz Leszczynski (Finland) and **Nam Kim** (South Korea) are the Technical Program Chairs.

The **Technical Program of BEMS 2010** will include Plenary Sessions, Plenary Topic-in-Focus Sessions, Plenary Round-Table Discussion, Tutorial Sessions, platform presentations (20min/talk) and poster sessions, a student paper competition, and exhibits. Original research studies are solicited for presentation (in English) on the interaction of biological systems with electromagnetic energy from static fields through the visible light frequencies. Areas of interest include, but are not limited to, the following categories: clinical devices; medical applications; high-throughput screening; *in vitro* studies; *in vivo* studies; mechanisms of interaction; theoretical and practical modeling; instrumentation and methodology; dosimetry; exposure standards; occupational exposure; epidemiology; public policy.

The **abstract submission deadline** is **January 15th, 2010**. In order to provide information early enough so that all conference participants can make travel arrangements early and save on travel costs, **there will be no extension of this deadline**. Any abstracts received after the deadline might be considered, at the discretion of TPC Chairs, only for poster presentation.

Authors wishing to present should submit a **short 100-word summary** and a **2-page abstract** (for details see below) electronically to www.BEMS2010.abstractcentral.com. Abstract submission must include:

- **100-word short summary** – A concise yet informative summary of the work is required for publication in the program book, if accepted. This short abstract should not repeat information already presented in the title of the presentation.
- **2-page abstract** - Sufficient context and detail must be included to allow the Technical Program Committee to readily make an assessment of the work for acceptance or rejection and for the type of presentation (oral or poster) if accepted. Abstracts should include Aim of Work, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion and Conclusions. The original work must be substantially complete. Abstracts that do not specifically refer to new results will not be considered for oral presentation.
